Please accept the attached written report of the number of acres of IDNR-managed lands that were open to hunting and/or trapping during calendar year 2020. The Illinois Hunting Heritage Protection Act (520 ILCS 30/) requires that the Director of the Department of Natural Resources provide the General Assembly with a report each year of the number of acres of IDNR-managed lands that have been either closed or opened to hunting and/or trapping.

The attached spreadsheet lists the sites and acreage open to hunting and/or trapping during calendar year 2020. A column is also included for the benchmark year of 2004 hunting season that illustrates any net loss or gain of the number of acres opened to hunting and/or trapping on IDNR-managed lands during this past hunting and trapping season. An additional sheet includes a figure showing the trend in total acres open to hunting and/or trapping since 2004.

I am pleased to report that there was a net gain of 48,664 acres on IDNR managed lands open to hunting and/or trapping since the bill passed in 2004 through the end of 2020. Additions and deletions are summarized within the spreadsheet. The 600 acre increase in 2020 was the result of opening formerly closed areas and new properties.
