2021 In-Car Video Camera Annual Report for Grant-Funded Systems

- (1) The number of cameras received by the law enforcement agency.
 The Department has received grant funding for a total of six (6) in-car video camera systems.
- The number of cameras actually installed in law enforcement agency vehicles.

 The Department operates a total of eight (8) in-car video camera systems, which include the aforementioned six (6) systems.
- (3) A brief description of the review process used by supervisors within the law enforcement agency.

 Each shift supervisor shall audit previously recorded events for each officer assigned to their shift, at least once a month. Audits are to verify compliance with Department's Mobile Video Recorder (MVR) policy and to ensure MVR equipment is functioning properly. Violations of the policy discovered during an audit may result in disciplinary action.
 - Supervisors are encouraged to audit the recordings more often and to make tactical and officer safety suggestions as appropriate. Each audit will be documented on an MVR System Audit in the Department's designated software.
- (4) A list of any criminal, traffic, ordinance, and civil cases in which in-car video recordings were used, including party names, case numbers, offenses charged, and disposition of the matter.

- (5) Any other information relevant to the administration of the program.
