On June 06, 2019 at approximately 1200 hours, I (Inspector Zook #9361) participated in an undercover narcotics operation in Peoria County. A Confidential source purchased 14.59 grams of suspected methamphetamine (field tested positive) from Taryn N. Lee (F/W, 10/29/1990) in an apartment complex located at 4010 N. Brandywine Dr. Apt. 813 Peoria, IL. The evidence was purchased with pre-recorded \$200.00 USC/OAF.

On 06/09/2018, Taryn Lee agreed to sell 1 ounce of methamphetamine (ice) to Inspector Zook on 06/10/2019. The exemption is requested due to the anticipated undercover operation at 1200 hours on 06/10/2019 between Taryn Lee and Inspector Zook.

Lee has a criminal history including a Bureau of Prisons record and is currently on Parole. Lee also has a Illinois criminal history including charges for assault, dangerous drugs, larceny, forgery, obstructing, public peace, and invasion of privacy. The most recent address listed for Lee is 811 W. Moss Ave Peoria, IL
