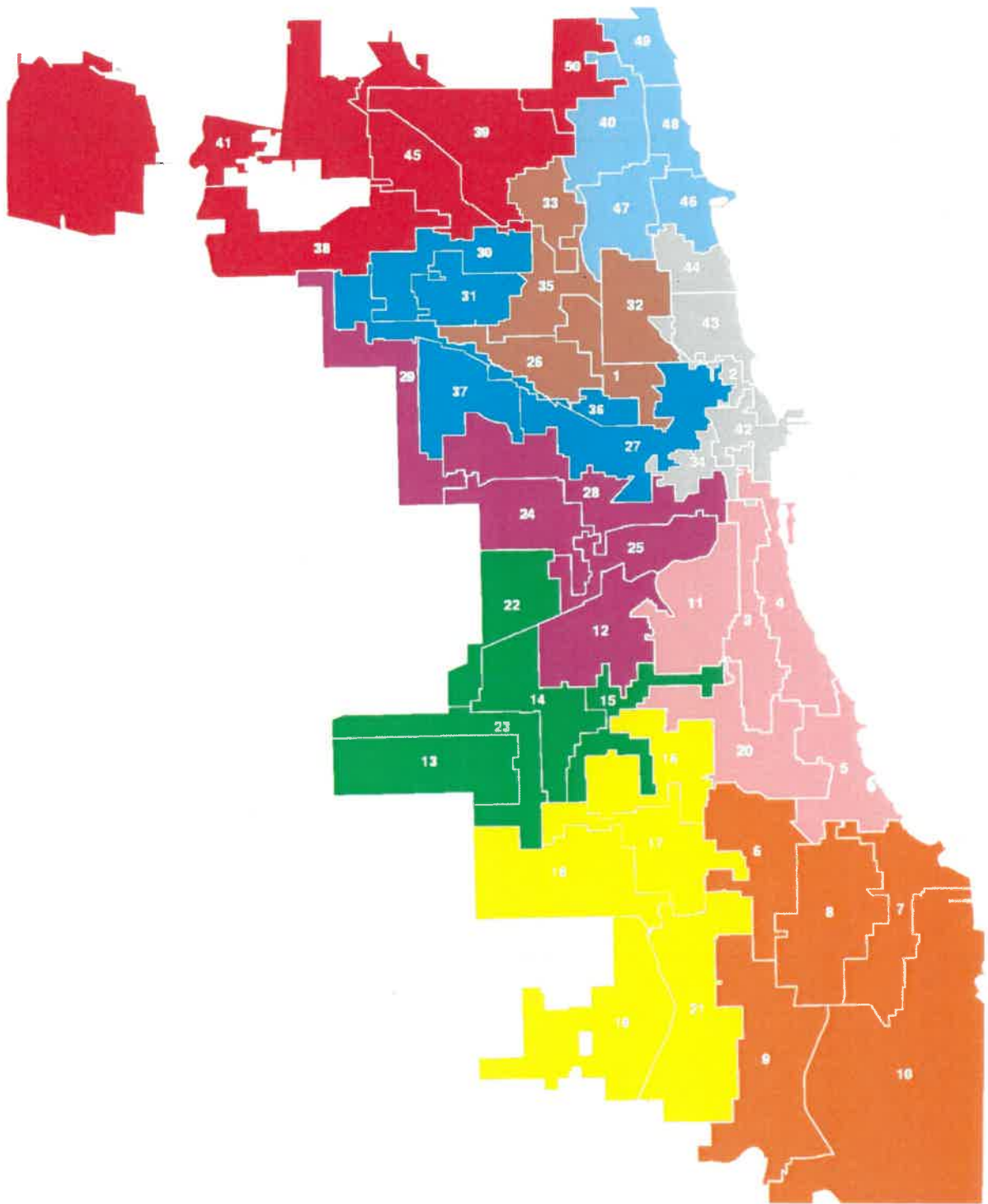


Annabel Faircloth – Self

“This map is a simple combination of wards using the most recent boundaries set in 2023. Overall, three districts (1, 2, and 5) should be majority-white, three majority-Hispanic (3, 6, and 7), and four majority-Black (4, 8, 9, and 10), roughly in proportion to the city's population. Despite the nonpartisan nature of these elections, each district was also drawn in an attempt to combine wards where local electeds are ideologically similar.”
