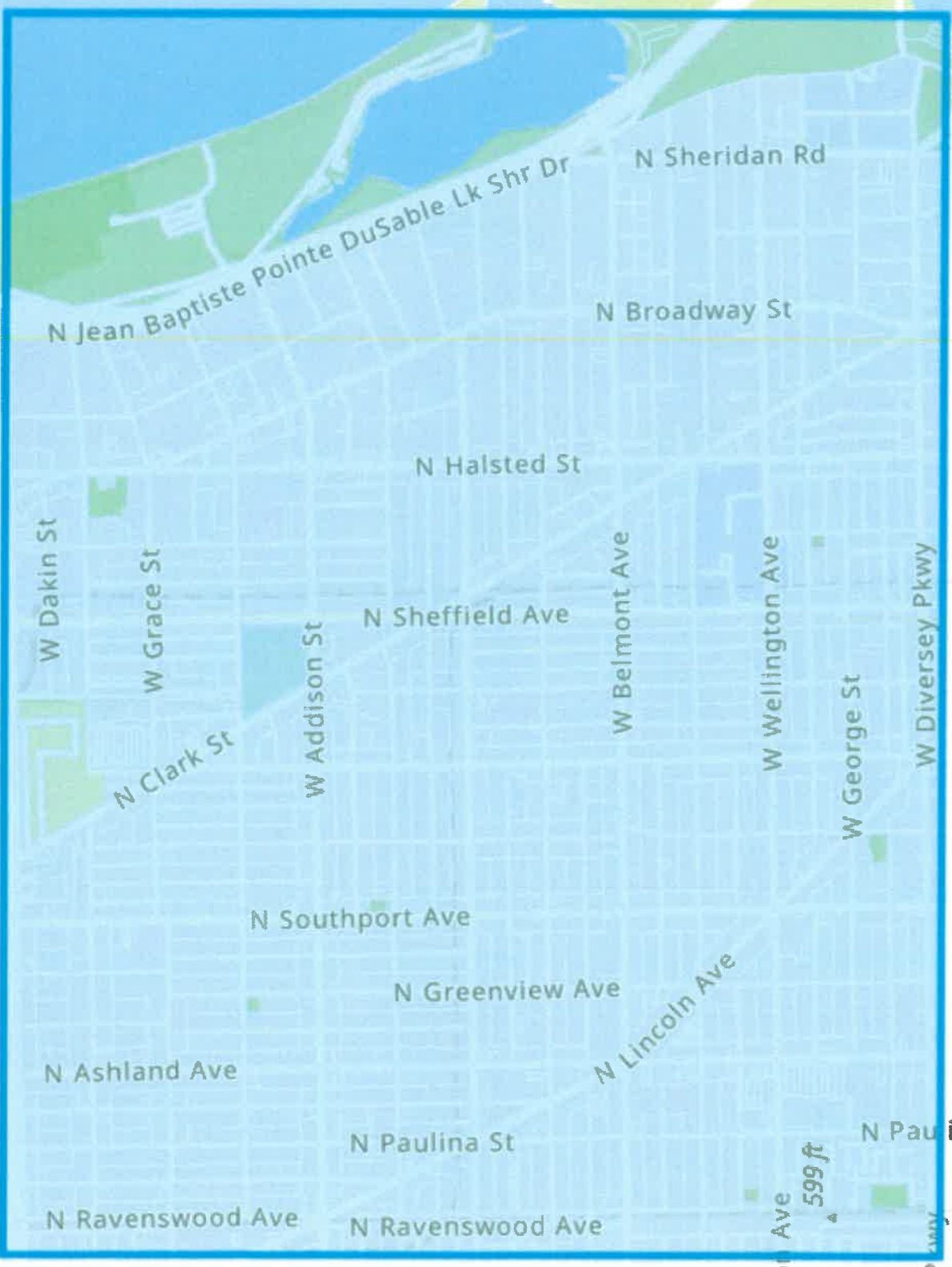

2010-2020 ANNUAL GROWTH RATE



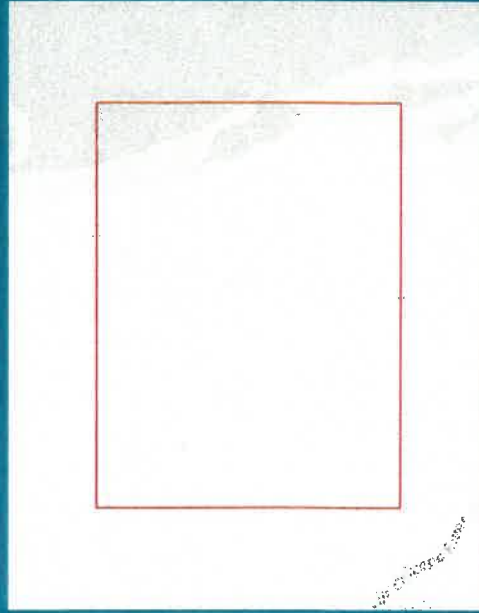

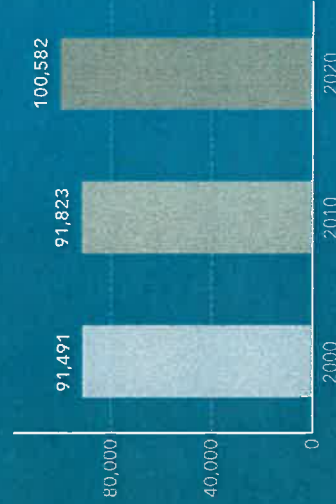

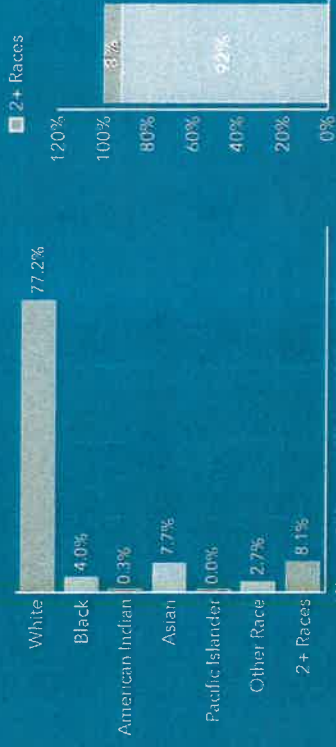

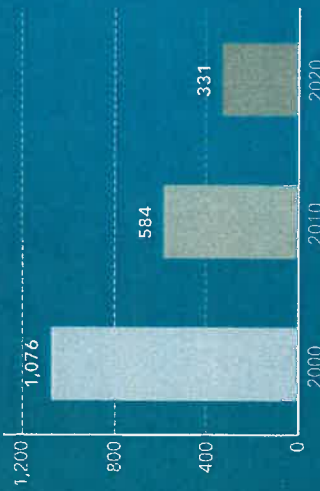
HOUSEHOLD POPULATION

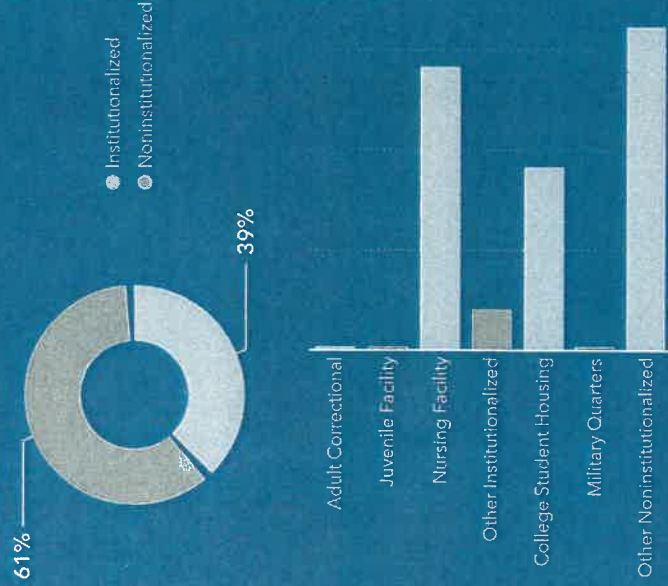
