President; and the House of Representatives stands adjourned until Friday, January 21, 2011, in perfunctory session; and when it adjourns on that day, it stands adjourned until Tuesday, January 25, 2011, in perfunctory session; and when it adjourns on that day, it stands adjourned until Friday, January 28, 2011, in perfunctory session; and when it adjourns on that day, it stands adjourned until Monday, January 31, 2011, in perfunctory session; and when it adjourns on that day, it stands adjourned until Tuesday, February 01, 2011, or until the call of the Speaker.

Ordered that the Secretary inform the House of Representatives thereof and ask their concurrence therein.

Senator Bomke asked and obtained unanimous consent for the purpose of a Republican caucus to begin immediately upon adjournment.
