2. The Senate will come to order. All those not entitled to the
3. Floor, please leave the Floor. Will the members be in their seats,
4. please. In the absence of a minister today, we would ask all of you
5. to stand and in your own way, to that God you know best, offer your
6. own individual prayer. Amen. The Chair recognizes Senator Cherry.

7. SENATOR CHERRY:

8. Mr. President, I now move that all bills introduced in the 77th
9. General Assembly which are presently on our Calendar or in any
10. standing or special Senate committee hereby be ordered Tabled and
11. stricken.

12. PRESIDING OFFICER: (Senator Partee)

13. Any comment? Senator Clarke. Did you say it should have happened
14. along time ago. I thought so. All in favor, opposed, motion is
15. carried. Chair recognizes Senator Cherry.

16. SENATOR CHERRY:

17. I now move, Mr. President, that the Senate of the 77th General
18. Assembly adopt a Senate Resolution which is in the hands of the
19. Secretary appointing a Committee of five to approve the final
20. Journal of the 77th General Assembly and move that the following
21. members be named to that Committee. Senator Gene Johns, Senator
22. Hynes, Senator Hall, Senator Harris and Senator Graham.

23. PRESIDING OFFICER: (Senator Partee)

24. Any comment? All in favor of this motion signify by saying
25. aye, any opposed. The motion is carried. Would you ring the bell
26. again Sergeant at Arms? Senator Clarke we're going to just hold
27. this a moment, its apparent that we are...Senator Cherry desires
28. to make a motion and on this motion I'm going to suggest we call the
29. roll. Senator Cherry.

31. Mr. President, as the last legislative action with respect to
32. the 77th General Assembly I now move that the Senate adopt the

14. I have a Resolution here pertaining to the recent death of
15. Roberto Clemente and I should like, if all possible, to get a sus-
16. pension of the rules for the immediate consideration and perhaps
17. adoption of this Resolution.

19. Senator Cherry will you hold your motion until we can proceed with
20. this. Senator Smith moves for the suspension of the rules and the
21. immediate adoption of a Resolution relating to Roberto Clemente a base-
22. ball player from the National League. He moves that this be immediatsly
23. adopted and that all Senators be made sponsors of this Resolution. All
