1. PRESIDENT:

2. Senate will come to order. The 1st Special Session  
3. of the 78th General Assembly will come to order. Prayer  
4. will be delivered by Reverend Bluford Dawson of the First  
5. United Methodist Church of Springfield. Reverend Dawson.

6. (Prayer by Reverend Dawson,  
7. First United Methodist Church,  
8. Springfield, Illinois)

9. Reading of the Journal. Senator Soper.

10. SENATOR SOPER:

11. Mr. President, Members of the Senate, I move that we  
12. postpone the approval and the reading of the Journal  
13. pending the arrival of the printed Journal.

14. PRESIDENT:

15. You've heard the motion. All in favor signify by  
16. saying aye. Contrary no. Motion carries. So ordered.  
17. Senator Partee, would you come to the podium please?  
18. ...Senate will be in recess. Just stand at ease or sit  
19. at ease for a few minutes. We're involved in a communication  
20. with the House about the time to which to adjourn the 1st  
21. Special Session. When we get that communication completed  
22. why we'll proceed with the adjournment of the 1st Special  
23. Session. Senator Rock, is Senator Partee in his office or...  
24. All right. Would you notify him, we are ready to proceed  
25. with that adjournment resolution of the 1st Special Session  
26. if...Senator Partee, we have the adjournment resolution  
27. for the 1st Special Session prepared that will adjourn it  
28. by means of the Joint Resolution initiated in the Senate  
29. this week to Monday at 2:00 p.m. That has...I think there  
30. is understanding from the joint leadership that there would  
31. be no action on the bills. There may be an announcement  
32. that you wish to make in connection with the Session, but  
33. we are ready to proceed with the adoption of this Resolution.

1. Senator Partee.

2. SENATOR PARTEE:

3. Yes, Senator Donnewald isn't here at the moment. We  
4. wanted to make an announcement that there'll be a Committee  
5. of the Whole hearing on his series of bills, I think it's  
6. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

7. PRESIDENT:

8. That's correct.

9. SENATOR PARTEE:

10. For Tuesday of next week at 2:30.

11. PRESIDENT:

12. All right, then, that's Tuesday, October 30th, at  
13. 2:30 p.m.. The 1st Special Session will be in convention  
14. and will proceed to a Committee of the Whole hearing on  
15. Senate Bills 1 through 5. Senator Donnewald is on the  
16. Floor now...that, the record can show that that was his  
17. request. On the motion to adjourn the Secretary will  
18. proceed with the Joint Resolution offered by Senator  
19. Graham.
