3. Session of the 78th General Assembly and the Senate will
4. come to order. Reading of the Journal.

7. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

8. Senator Soper.

9. SENATOR SOPER:

10. Mr. President, I move that we dispense with the further
11. reading of the Journal of October 22nd. Unless there's some cor-
12. rections or additions to be made that the Journal stand approved.

13. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

14. All in favor of the motion, signify by saying aye. Opposed.
15. The ayes have it. The motion carries.

16. SECRETARY:

18. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

19. Senator Soper.

20. SENATOR SOPER:

21. Mr. President, I move that the...we dispense with the

26. You have heard the motion. All in favor will signify
27. by saying aye. Opposed. The motion carries.

33. Mr. President, I move that we dispense with the further

1. reading of the Journal of October 24th. Unless there's
2. some additions or corrections to be made that the Journal
3. stand approved.

4. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

5. All in favor of the motion just made by the Senator
6. from Cicero will signify by saying aye. Opposed. The
7. ayes have it. The motion carries. Senator Soper.

8. SENATOR SOPER:

9. Mr. President, I move that we postpone the reading and
10. the approval of the Journal of October 25th pending the
11. arrival of the printed Journal.

12. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

13. You have heard the motion of Senator Soper. All in
14. favor will signify by saying aye. Opposed. The ayes have
15. it and the motion carries. Senator Harris, what is your
16. disposition with regard to the 3rd Session, which is
17. opened, duly opened for business?

18. SENATOR HARRIS:

19. I am only familiar with the fact that...we probably
20. should advance Senator Carroll's bill and then I think
21. there are...we...we have some questions about SB 6. I
22. don't know whether the other sponsors want to proceed with
23. considering those bills or just...not take action as far
24. as passage is concerned, but just advance 20 and adjourn
25. until 1:30 tomorrow.

26. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

27. If it is the desire of Senator Carroll, HB...SB 20
28. will be read a 2nd time prior to advancement.

29. SECRETARY:

30. SB 20 (Secretary reads title of the bill)
31. 2nd reading of the bill. No committee amendments.

32. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

33. Are there amendments from the Floor? Hearing none,

1. 3rd reading. Senator ParTEE.

2. SENATOR PARTEE:

3. I'm sorry if I'm repeating something you've already
4. said, but did I understand you to say you have no questions
5. as to 4 and 5?

6. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

7. Senator Harris said that. I did not.

8. SENATOR HARRIS:

9. Yes, I indicated that I thought really we'd be in a
10. better posture to move on them later in the Session. We
11. really weren't quite ready. But, my staff work analysis
12. reports to me that we do not have questions on 4, 5 and
13. 16 but I did say further that I didn't think that we were
14. under any need to take precipitous action on them and why
15. didn't we wait on them. ...

16. SENATOR PARTEE:

17. Well, I don't have any desire to take precipitous action,
18. but I do have a desire to move things if we...when we get to
19. them if there is no objection to them. If we could move 4 and
20. 5, you have some questions on 6, we have some questions on 16,
21. which I don't think will create any furors. This is an
22. administration measure. We'll get back to it. But let's...
23. could we get 4 and 5 out of the way at this time? It will
24. only take a minute. There's no objection to it on either
25. side of the aisle.

26. SENATOR HARRIS:

27. Well, why don't we take 16 first? I like that number
28. best.

29. SENATOR PARTEE:

30. Well, 16 is the one that I have just a question or two
31. about. I submit to you that it's an administration bill.
32. Maybe I shouldn't have any question about it, but this
33. Senator wants to know a little more about it.---I don't

1. care whose bill it is, the administration, the Governor's
2. or you know someone's father. I want to know a little
3. more about it.

4. SENATOR HARRIS:

5. We didn't have a chance to discuss these...let's just
6. put them all over. ...Senator Carroll's bill will have
7. caught up with these tomorrow and...we can I think, probably
8. deal with all of them at once tomorrow.

9. SENATOR PARTEE:

10. All right. We'll wait till tomorrow on all of them.

11. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

12. That discussion having been completed, is there further
13. business to be... . That question having been debated, is
14. there further business to be brought before this Special
15. Session of the General Assembly? Senator Harris.

16. SENATOR HARRIS:

17. I just want to inquire...I was diverted here. SB 20
18. was advanced was it not? ...to 3rd.

19. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

20. Ok. Fine. I now, unless there is further
21. business, I move to adjourn the 3rd Special Session until
22. 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, October 30th.

23. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR GRAHAM):

24. All in favor of the motion signify by saying aye.
25. Opposed. The ayes have it and the motion carries.
