1. PRESIDENT:

2. The First Special Session will come to order. Reading
3. of the Journal. Senator Shapiro.

4. SENATOR SHAPIRO:

5. Mr. President, Members of the Senate, I move that
6. we postpone the reading and approval of the Journal for
7. Tuesday, November 13th, 1973, Wednesday, November 14th,
8. and Thursday, November 15th, 1973 of the First Special
9. Session until the arrival of the printed copies.

10. PRESIDENT:

11. Senator Shapiro moves that the Journals of November
12. 13th, 14th and 15 be postponed until the arrival of the
13. printed Journals. All in favor signify by saying aye.
14. Contrary no. The motion carries, so ordered. Messages

18. PRESIDENT:

19. ...Glass.

20. SENATOR GLASS:

21. Thank you Mr. President. I would move that HB 19
22. of the First Special Session be read a 1st time and
23. advanced to 2nd reading without reference to committee.

24. PRESIDENT:

25. ...Senator Glass has moved that the bill be read
26. a 1st time and advanced to the order of 2nd reading
27. without reference. Just a minute Mr. Secretary. For
28. what purpose does Senator Graham arise?

29. SENATOR GRAHAM :

30. Mr. President, I have no real desire to stand in
31. the way of consideration of more ethics legislation.
32. I do have a desire I think joined by most of the members
33. of the General Assembly that we've pretty well up to

1. our hips in ethics legislation and I don't see at this
2. time why we should go in the advancement of those bills,
3. I'm going to object.

4. PRESIDENT:

5. Senator Graham, there is an objection. Do you wish
6. to suspend...move to suspend the rules Senator Class? Maybe
7. a...

8. SENATOR GLASS:

9. Well Mr. President it's true this bill has to do
10. with ethics, actually I think it's a bill that...it may be
11. very helpful. It...requires that all officials be given
12. 45 days notice they must file their economic interest.
13. If they haven't done so then a 15 day notice. In other
14. words it tries to face up to the problem of...to persons
15. not filing ethics statements because they simply forget
16. or...do not know about them. I...I don't feel strongly
17. about it. If Senator Graham objects I...I guess it can
18. go to committee and we may not get to it anyway, but...
19. I would like it moved to 2nd. But if he persists the
20. objection I will not.

21. PRESIDENT:

22. Senator Graham.

23. SENATOR GRAHAM:

24. I don't feel that strongly about it, the only thing
25. is I think we're going to get another piece of legislation
26. on the Calendar with which we're not going to be able to
27. deal.

29. Well, all right. Senator Graham persists, so we'll
30. ..pursue it's regular procedure then. Is there any
31. further business to come before the First Special Session?
32. Senator Graham moves that the First Special Session stand
33. in recess subject to the call of the Chair. All in favor
