21. Senator Soper.

22. SENATOR SOPER:

23. I move that we dispense with the further reading

32. SENATOR PARTEE:

33. Mr. President, on SB 2 which is now on the Secretary's

1. desk...is on the Table, I'm moving to suspend the rules
2. to take SB 2 from the Table and place it on the order of
3. second reading. Now implicit and included in that motion
4. is my desire to make Senator Conolly the lead co-sponsor
5. on that bill.

6. PRESIDENT:

7. Senator Partee moves to suspend the rules for the
8. purpose of taking from the Table SB 2 and to have Senator
9. Conolly shown as the principle sponsor of the bill. Is
10. there discussion? All in favor signify by saying aye.
11. Contrary no. The motion to suspend and to proceed with
12. the elements of Senator Partee's motion carries. So
13. ordered. Senator Partee.

14. SENATOR PARTEE:

15. Now I move that the bill be read a second time and
16. advanced to the order of third reading. This, with the
17. understanding that it can be brought back tomorrow for
18. amendment.

19. PRESIDENT:

20. On the order of second reading, SB 2.

21. SECRETARY:

22. SB 2. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
23. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

24. PRESIDENT:

25. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
26. There is a clear understanding that the bill will be recalled
27. from third to second tomorrow for purposes of amendment con-
28. sideration. Senator Mitchler.

29. SENATOR MITCHLER:

30. ...Mr. President, after your last statement would this
31. apply to all bills that are advanced to third reading. Would
32. they be given the proper consideration to be brought back to
33. second if amendments are desired to be offered?

6. Mr. President, with reference to SB 3 I now move to
7. discharge the Transportation Committee from further con-
8. sideration of that bill.

9. PRESIDENT:

10. Senator Partee moves to discharge the Committee on
11. Transportation and Public Utilities from further consideration
12. of SB 3. All in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary no.
13. The...the motion carries. So ordered. Senator Partee.

14. SENATOR PARTEE:

15. Now Mr. President I move that the bill be read a second
16. time and advanced to third reading under the prior arrangement.

17. PRESIDENT:

18. SB 3 on the order of second reading, the Secretary
19. will proceed.

20. SECRETARY:

21. SB 3. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
22. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

23. PRESIDENT:

24. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
25. On the order of motions Senate...Senator Rock is recognized.

26. SENATOR ROCK:

27. Thank you Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the
28. Senate, I would move at this time to suspend the rules for
29. the purpose of moving to reconsider the vote by which SB 27
30. was defeated.

31. PRESIDENT:

32. Senator Rock moves to suspend the rules for the purpose
33. of reconsidering SB 27. The motion...I'm sorry to reconsider

27. Thank you Mr. President. Having voted on the prevailing
28. side I do now move to reconsider the vote by which SB 27 was
29. defeated.

30. PRESIDENT:

31. The Senator...Rock has moved to reconsider the vote by
32. which SB 27 was defeated and on that question the Secretary
33. will call the roll.

13. Bell, no. Senator Bruce, aye. On that question
14. the yeas are 42. The nays are 11. SB 27 is reconsidered.
15. Senator Rock...Senator Rock.

16. SENATOR ROCK:

17. Yes. Just a point of inquiry Mr. President, my under-
18. standing now that that vote...that motion having been successful
19. the bill will now be on the Calendar in the position of
20. 3rd reading. Is that correct?

21. PRESIDENT:

22. That is correct.

23. SENATOR ROCK:

24. Thank you.

25. PRESIDENT:

26. Senator Conolly...you wish to take any further action
27. then on SB 27 at this time? All right the bill will remain
28. on third reading. On the order of motions, Senator Hynes.

29. SENATOR HYNES:

30. Mr. President, SB 38 is presently in the Appropriations
31. Committee. I would move to discharge the Appropriations
32. Committee from further consideration of SB 38 and ask that it
33. be brought to the order of second reading.

1. PRESIDENT:

2. Senator Hynes moves that the Committee on Appropriations
3. be discharged from further consideration of SB 38. All in
4. favor of the motion signify by saying aye. Contrary no. The
5. motion carries. SB 38 is discharged from the Committee on
6. Appropriations. It is now on the order of second reading.
7. The Secretary will proceed with the second reading of the bill.

8. SECRETARY:

9. SB 38. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
10. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

11. PRESIDENT:

12. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
13. Now on the order of Senate Bills on second reading SB 42.

14. SECRETARY:

15. SB 42. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
16. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

17. PRESIDENT:

18. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
19. SB 43.

20. SECRETARY:

21. SB 43. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
22. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

23. PRESIDENT:

24. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
25. SB 44.

26. SECRETARY:

27. SB 44. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
28. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

29. PRESIDENT:

30. Are there amendments from the Floor? ...Senator
31. Conolly did you wish to make a motion in connection with
32. SB 44?

33. SENATOR CONOLLY:

Yes, Mr. President, I'd move that we Table this bill.

1. PRESIDENT:

2. Senator Conolly has moved to Table SB 44. All in
3. favor of the motion signify by saying aye. Contrary no.
4. The motion carries, the bill is Tabled. SB 45.

5. SECRETARY:

6. SB 45. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
7. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

8. PRESIDENT:

9. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
10. SB 46.

11. SECRETARY:

12. SB 46. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
13. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

14. PRESIDENT:

15. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.
16. Senator Rock.

17. SENATOR ROCK:

18. Yes, thank you Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen
19. of the Senate. If I can have the attention of our members
20. and I'm sure some of yours there was some question pursuant
21. to our agreement of the other evening. Some of our members
22. have indicated they wish to co-sponsor one or another of these
23. bills. I would ask leave at this time that any member who
24. wishes to be co-sponsor of any of these bills would leave his name
25. with the Secretary and I think if..if we just unanimous consent that
26. they can go down there and give their that'll...

27. PRESIDENT:

28. Yes. Senator Rock has asked for unanimous consent of
29. the Senate for any Senator to join as a co-sponsor on any of
30. this series of bills. Is there leave? Leave is granted. The
31. members are instructed that those of you who wish to join as
32. co-sponsor on any of these bills to approach the Secretary and
33. advise him of your wish. And the Journal will show this action.

1. Senator Hall...Harber Hall.

2. SENATOR HARBER HALL:

3. Mr. President, I wonder if it would be appropriate
4. to ask since SB 27 has been reconsidered...would it be
5. appropriate to ask that my name be removed as a co-sponsor
6. of this bill at this time?

7. PRESIDENT:

8. That is your right. You can seek leave of the Senate.
9. Senator Hall seeks leave of the Senate to be removed as a
10. co-sponsor of SB 27. Is there leave? Leave is granted.
11. So ordered. House Bills on second reading.

12. SECRETARY:

13. HB 42...HB 42. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
14. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

15. PRESIDENT:

16. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.

17. SECRETARY:

18. HB 43...HB 43. (Secretary reads title of the bill).
19. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee amendments.

20. PRESIDENT:

21. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading.

22. The Chair wishes to announce that the amendment being prepared
23. to SB 27 is going through the zerox machine now. We physically
24. got the amendment slightly more than 20 minutes ago. It is a
25. 58 page amendment. It will take quite some time yet for it
26. to be reproduced and collated. That those of you who wish to
27. receive have a copy of it for your use this evening yet and
28. before reconvention tomorrow if you will come to the President's
29. office just as quickly as they become physically available we
30. will make them available to you. It might be...that if you...
31. the supply will be there just as quickly as it can be done and
32. they will be available for those of you who do not wish to wait
33. for them tonight, the first thing on your arrival in the morning.
Just so that the members are aware, our schedule of adjournment

1. previously adopted are these: The Regular Session will
2. reconvene tomorrow morning at 9. The Second Special at
3. 9:15. The Fourth at 9:30. The Fifth at 9:45. The First

10. Special Session stand adjourned until 10:15 a.m. Thursday,

12. PRESIDENT:

13. Senator Weaver has moved that the Third Special
14. Session until 10:15 a.m. Thursday, November 29th. All in
15. favor signify by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion carries.
16. The Senate stands adjourned until 10:15 in the Third Special
17. Session. It will reconvene in the Regular Special Session
18. at 9 tomorrow morning.

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
