1 PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR ROCK)

2 The Second Special Session of the 79th General Assembly will  
3 come to order. Reading of the Journal, Senator Wooten.

4 SENATOR WOOTEN:

5 Mr. President, I move that reading and approval of the Journals  
6 of Monday, April 26th, 1976, Tuesday, April 27th, 1976, and Wednesday,  
7 April 28th, 1976, be postponed pending arrival of the printed Journals.

9 You've heard the motion. All those in favor signify by saying  
10 Aye. All those opposed. The Ayes have it. So ordered. A message  
11 from the House.

14 Mr. President - I'm directed to inform the Senate that the  
15 House of Representatives has adopted the following joint resolution  
16 in the adoption of which I am instructed to the concurrence of  
17 the Senate, to-wit:

20 PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR ROCK)

21 Okay. It's House Joint Resolution 2. Senator Wooten moves  
22 for the suspension of the rules for the immediate consideration  
23 and adoption of this house joint resolution. All in favor signify by  
24 saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are  
25 suspended. Senator Wooten now moves for the adoption of House  
26 Joint Resolution 2. All those in favor signify by saying Aye.  
27 All those opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted.  
28 Senator Wooten...Senator Brady now moves pursuant to that House  
29 Joint Resolution that the Second Special Session stand adjourned  
30 until Tuesday, May 18th. So ordered.
