10.           Senator Rock, Senator Partee has talked to me about the problem  
11. that you have, and has allowed me to advance it to 3rd with the under-  
12. standing that we'll hold it until the Office of Education gets a chance  
13. to get back and talk to us.

14. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

15.           Do you want to proceed with it, Senator?

16. SENATOR SCHAFFER:

17.           With Senator Rock's permission, yes.

18. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

19.           Oh. The question is shall Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 384  
20. pass. All those in favor say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have  
21. it. Senate Amendment No. 1 is adopted. As to Amendment No. 2 to Senate  
22. Bill 384, all those in favor of Amendment No. 2 indicate by saying Aye.  
23. All those opposed No. The Ayes have it. The amendment is adopted. Are  
24. there further amendments? 3rd reading. Senator Bloom. Senator Bloom  
25. do you wish to move the bill that you asked me about several minutes  
26. ago? Senate Bill 1053. Read the bill.

27. SECRETARY:

28.           Senate Bill 1053.

29.           (Secretary reads title of bill)

30. 2nd reading of the bill. No committee amendments. No...no committee  
31. amendments. Is there...you have a Floor Amendment? No committee  
32. amendments.

33. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

1. Are there amendments from the Floor? 3rd reading. Senator Newhouse,  
2. for what purpose do you arise?

3. SENATOR NEWHOUSE:

4. Senator, I am the cosponsor with Senator Kosinski on Senate Bill  
5. 57. Senator Kosinski is in the hospital and I'd like to move that to  
6. 3rd with the understanding we'll pull it back to 2nd if any amendments  
7. are necessary.

8. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

9. We'll put that on the list, Senator.

10. SENATOR NEWHOUSE:

11. Thank you.

12. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

13. Senator Hall, Senate Bill 1109. Senator Clarke is not present  
14. because of circumstances at home, would you...you indicate that you  
15. wish to move the bill for Senator Clarke. Read the bill.

16. SECRETARY:

17. Senate Bill 1109.

18. (Secretary reads title of bill)

19. 2nd reading of the bill. The Committee on Executive offers one amend-  
20. ment.

21. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

22. Senator Harber Hall.

23. SENATOR HALL:

24. This...this bill in committee, I believe there was one amendment  
25. put on in committee. Senator Rock has an amendment he would like to  
26. substitute for that. I have read the amendment and would agree with  
27. it.

28. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

29. Senator Rock.

30. SENATOR ROCK:

31. Thank you, Mr. President. Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 1109 is  
32. an agreed amendment which the committee agreed upon with the Auditor

31. ...amendments from the Floor? Senator Hickey.
32. SECRETARY:
33. ...one Floor Amendment offered by Senator Hickey.

23. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
24. Senator Vadalabene moves that the Senate resolve itself into the
25. Committee of the Whole...resolve itself into Executive Session for the
26. purpose of considering appointments by the Governor. All those in
27. favor say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have it. We are now in
28. Executive Session. Senator Vadalabene.
29. SENATOR VADALABENE:
30. Yes, Mr. President, and members of the Senate. Unless there is
31. objection, I ask leave to consider all the following nominations on
32. one roll call.
33. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

1. Is there objection? Proceed, Senator Vadalabene.

17. of 2nd reading for the purpose of amendment. All those in favor  
18. say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have it. We are now  
19. in 2nd reading. Senator Bloom as to Senate Bill 676.

20. SENATOR BLOOM:

21. 76, Mr. President. Yeah, we had amended this bill and there  
22. was some technical errors in the amendment cause they didn't  
23. strike certain things and I have conferred with Senator Welsh and  
24. Senator Daley about the amendments and so this merely clarifies

27. Is it your desire, Senator, to reconsider the vote by which

29. SENATOR BLOOM:

30. Yes, Mr. President.

31. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

32. That is the motion. Senator Bloom moves that the Senate shall...ho

1. shall reconsider, having voted on the prevailing side, shall reconsider  
2. the vote by which Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 676 was adopted. All  
3. those in favor say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have it.  
4. SENATOR BLOOM:  
5. All right, now I'd like to...  
6. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
7. Now...now reconsidered the amendment. He now moves to Table Amend-  
8. ment No. 1 to Senate Bill 676. All those in favor say Aye. All those  
9. opposed No. The Ayes have it. The amendment is Tabled. Senate...  
10. Senator Bloom.  
11. SENATOR BLOOM:  
12. Yeah, Now I'd like to put on a corrected...the correct amendment.  
13. I guess would that be Amendment No. 2.  
14. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
15. That will be Amendment No. 2.  
16. SENATOR BLOOM:  
17. All right. I'd...I'd offer Amendment No. 2.

32. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
33. Senate Bill 595, Senator Wooten.

27. Mr. President, I'd like unanimous consent to return Senate Bill 646
28. to the order of 2nd reading and...
29. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
30. Is there leave?
31. SENATOR COURSE:
32. having...having...
33. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

1. Leave is granted.

2. SENATOR COURSE:

3. Having voted on the prevailing side I now move to reconsider  
4. the vote by which Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 646 was passed.

5. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

6. Senator Course having prevail...voted on the prevailing side as  
7. to Amendment No. 1 to 646 moves that that vote be reconsidered. All  
8. those in favor say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have it. The  
9. measure is reconsidered. Senator Course now moves that the Senate Amend-  
10. ment No. 1 to Senate Bill 646 be Tabled. All those in favor, say Aye.  
11. Oh, just a moment. Senator Course.

12. SENATOR COURSE:

13. I'm sorry, Mr. President. That was Amendment No. 2. I'm...

20. There's no way...there is no way of telling, I suppose. Well, let's  
21. just try. They're moving some bills back for clarification are they?

22. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

23. Yes, from 3rd to 2nd.

24. SENATOR PARTEE:

25. Well, let's try a few and see how...how well they...we get along.

26. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

27. Senate...Senate Bill 735, Senator Nimrod, the bill is on 3rd reading.  
28. You ask leave of the Body to return to the order of 2nd reading. All  
29. those in favor say Aye. Those opposed No. We are now on 2nd reading.  
30. Senator Nimrod.

31. SENATOR NIMROD:

32. I would move for the adoption of Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill 735  
33. as amended. And this is strictly technical, what's happened is when



1. we put Amendment No. 1 on, they misnumbered the paragraph letters,  
2. C and D and it just straightens that out and I would move for the  
3. adoption.

4. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

5. That is Amendment No. ...

6. SENATOR NIMROD:

7. 2.

8. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

9. Senator Nimrod moves that Amendment No. 2 be adopted to Senate Bill  
10. 735. All those in favor say Aye. All those opposed No. The Ayes have  
11. it. The amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments? 3rd  
12. reading. Senator McCarthy.

13. SENATOR MC CARTHY:

14. Yes, this is on, Mr. President and members of the Senate, on Senate  
15. Bill 459. I'd like to have that brought back to 2nd reading for the  
16. purpose of amendment. The amendment is on the Secretary's Desk.

17. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)

18. Is there leave? Leave is...leave is granted. Senator McCarthy.

19. SENATOR MC CARTHY:

20. Yes, Mr. President. I believe there is an amendment to Senate Bill

32. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:

33. Mr. President, I have two amendments to Senate Bill 295 and 296.

11. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
12. Just...just a moment, Senator. Let's deal with Senate Bill 295.
13. Senator Dougherty.
14. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:
15. This bill...
16. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
17. What...what amendment are we addressing...
18. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:
19. No. 1.
20. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
21. Amendment 1. Senator Dougherty.
22. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:
23. Amendment No. 1. This amendment provides...the bill 295 provides
24. for an increase in the cost of living benefits to an annuitant in the
25. county...Cook County Employees Pension Fund. It provides an increase
26. in the contribution of the employee of one half of one percent. It goes
27. from eight and a half to nine percent. This is to accommodate the
28. cost of living increase. We have all...we have also increased the
29. multiple for the employers in the original bill. This brings it in
30. line and will make the fund more solvent.
31. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)
32. Is there further discussion? All those in favor of adopting
33. Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 295 indicate by saying Aye. All those

1. opposed No. The Ayes have it. The amendment is adopted. 3rd reading.  
2. ...Are there further amendments? 3rd reading. Senate Bill 296, Senator  
3. Dougherty.  
4. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:  
5. ... (Machine cut-off)...provides precisely the same thing, they are  
6. companion bills, it increases the employees contribution one half of  
7. one percent.  
8. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
9. Is there further discussion? The question is shall Amendment No. 1  
10. to Senate Bill 296 pass. All those in favor say Aye. All those opposed  
11. No. The Ayes have it. The amendment is adopted. Are there further  
12. amendments? 3rd reading. Now...Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate, as  
13. to motions regarding Senate Bill 206, 628, 689. The motions...the agree-  
14. ment was to argue those motions today. The...a...is it the wish of the  
15. Body to postpone the argument of those motions until tomorrow. Do we  
16. have leave? I'm sorry...till Tuesday, till Tuesday. Do we have leave?  
17. Leave is granted. They are now set for Tuesday, May 6th. Senator  
18. Partee.  
19. SENATOR PARTEE:  
20. Yes, Mr. President.  
21. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
22. The hour is past 10:30 and the committees are to convene at this  
23. time. If there's...  
24. SENATOR PARTEE:  
25. Fine. Mr. President and members of the Senate.  
26. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR DONNEWALD)  
27. Your attention, please.  
28. SENATOR PARTEE:  
29. I want to make an announcement that I think you'll find extremely  
30. important. Our schedule for tomorrow, May 2nd, shows several commit-  
31. tees meeting tomorrow with a Session scheduled for 7:00 p.m.. That  
32. schedule was prepared at a time when we could not tell how many bills  
33. would be left in our committees, hence we felt we needed the entire

1. day for committee action and the evening for Floor action. As we now  
2. read it, it occurs to us that we can obviate a 7:00 o'clock meeting  
3. tomorrow night. Hence, the new schedule will be when we leave today,  
4. we will come in Session at noon tomorrow. It will be perhaps a short  
5. Session, but we will come in at noon tomorrow and the committees as  
6. scheduled will be in operation as scheduled. Some of our members of  
7. course will be here after the Session, because they are on committees  
8. that are scheduled after the Sessions, others will be of course, free.  
9. And then we will not come back either Saturday or Sunday or Monday. We  
10. will come back Tuesday then at noon as previously announced. Are there

21. That...that is correct, Senator, and I think we should be reminded  
22. again that the six day notice does go into effect on House Bills. There  
23. are many House Bills that could be heard and eliminate a traffic jam
