1. PRESIDENT:

2. The Second Special Session is called to order. Reading
3. of the Journal. Senator Joyce.

4. SENATOR JOYCE:

5. I move that reading and approval of the Journal of Wednesday,
6. November 5th, 1975, be postponed pending the arrival of the printed
7. Journal.

8. PRESIDENT:

9. You heard the motion, all in favor will say Aye. Opposed
10. Nay. The motion carries. Committee Reports.

11. SECRETARY:

12. Senator Donnewald, Chairman of the Assignment of Bills,
13. assigns the following bills to Committee:

14. Executive Committee - Senate Bill No. 2.

15. PRESIDENT:

16. Is there a motion concerning that bill? Senator Netsch.

17. SENATOR NETSCH:

18. Mr. President, is it a motion to discharge now because I
19. moved to discharge Senate Bill 2 from further consideration
20. of the Executive Committee and have it placed on the Calendar
21. on the order of 2nd reading.

22. PRESIDENT:

23. You heard the motion. All in favor will say Aye. Opposed
24. Nay. The motion carries. Senate Bills on 2nd reading. Senator
25. Dougherty.

26. SENATOR DOUGHERTY:

27. Thank you, Mr. President. Senate Bill No. 1, I would like
28. to advance that to the order of 3rd reading, however I'm informed.
29. that there is to be an amendment offered to this bill and I believe
30. Senator Harris has the amendment.

32. Senate...

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Read the bill a 2nd time.
2. SECRETARY:
3. Senate Bill No. 1.
4. (Secretary reads title of bill)
5. 2nd reading of the bill. No Committee Amendments. One Floor
6. Amendment, offered by Senator Harris.
7. PRESIDENT:
8. Senator Harris is recognized.
9. SENATOR HARRIS:
10. Thank you, Mr. President. This amendment would change the
11. ultimate term of the chairman from...a succeeding five year period.
12. to five years the first term...excuse me...
13. PRESIDENT:
14. Would the Page bring the Senator some water, please.
15. SENATOR HARRIS:
16. And four years each succeeding term. It would then put that
17. term...that terms commencement thereafter always in the odd numbered
18. year, the year in the interim from general elections, which we think
19. would be a...an appropriate and wise course of action. There is
20. one further effect of this amendment and that is that it would
21. change the terms of the members from July 1 to May 1, including
22. the chairman, and that is that it seems to us that the month of June is
23. so busy anyway that this would bring us into a resolution of who
24. the members would be during April and get that work done in April
25. and just...this amendment I do believe makes sense and I move its
26. adoption.
27. PRESIDENT:
28. Any discussion? Senator Harris moves...Senator Harris, the
29. water please...Senator Harris moves the adoption of Amendment No. 1
30. to Senate Bill 1. All in favor will say Aye. Opposed Nay. The
31. amendment is adopted. Any further amendments? 3rd reading. Any
32. further business to come before the Second Special Session? Resolutions.
33. SECRETARY:

1. Senate Joint Resolution No. 1, introduced by Senator Rock.

2. (Secretary reads Senate Joint Resolution No. 1)

3. PRESIDENT:

4. Senator Rock moves the suspension of the rules for the
5. immediate consideration of this Resolution. All in favor will
6. say Aye. Opposed Nay. The rules are suspended. Senator Rock
7. now moves for the adoption, immediate adoption of this Resolution.

8. All in favor say Aye. Opposed Nay. The Resolution is adopted.

9. Any further business to come before the Second Special Session?

10. Senator Donnewald moves that we adjourn. All in favor say Aye.

11. Opposed Nay. We are in adjournment. Senator Mohr.

12. SENATOR MOHR:

13. Yes Mr. President, I have a bill that I filed with the
14. Secretary earlier today that should go into the Regular Session
15. and I just would like it introduced and...and follow the regular
16. course when you get into that.

17. PRESIDENT:

18. Is it an appropriation bill?

19. SENATOR MOHR:

20. No, it's...I'd say it's...
