- 1. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 2. The First Special Session shall come to order. Reading
- 3. of the Journal. Senator Johns is recognized.
- 4. SENATOR JOHNS:
- 5. Thank you, Mr. President. I move that reading and
- 6. approval of the Journals of Wednesday, November the 16th,
- 7. Thursday, November the 17th, Tuesday, November the 22nd
- 8. and Wednesday, November the 23rd in the year 1977 be
- 9. postponed pending arrival of the printed Journal.
- 10. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 11. You heard the motion. All in favor say Aye. Opposed
- 12. Nay. The Ayes have it. The motion prevails. On the
- 13. Order of Motions. Motions in Writing, Senator Glass.
- 14. Senator Glass is recognized.
- 15. SENATOR GLASS:
- Thank you, Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen.
- 17. have filed a Motion in Writing which is to delete from
- 18. Senate Journal No. 9 of the First Special Session, Wed-
- 19. nesday, November 16, 1977, the following on page 2 and
- 20. page 3 after the adjournment until 12:15 o'clock p. m.
- 21. on Thursday. And then, Mr. President, what follows is
- 22. a motion by Senator Rock to reconsider an adjournment
- 23. motion and the...the background of this is that at the
- 24. time Senator Rock made that motion to reconsider the
- 25. vote by which the Senate stood adjourned from the First
- 26. Special Session, the Session had already been adjourned
- 27. and the Body was in the Second Special Session. There
- 28. was a debate and argument over the propriety of adjourning
- 29. a Special Session and then moving to reconsider the vote
- 30. by which the First Special Session had adjourned. And
- 31. the point was made on this side of the aisle that that
- 32. was not...that was simply impossible. That once the First
- 33. Special Session had adjourned it could not be reconvened.

- So what we...that position did not prevail, I might add.
- 2. But what we are attempting to do with this motion is to
- place the motion of Senator Rock and the...the material
- 4. following it in the Journal of the Second Special Session
- since that is where...Senator Rock made his motion. We
- were in the Second Special Session and we're...we're
- 7. actually trying to place the material set forth in my
- 8. motion in the Journal of the Second Special Session rather
- 9. than in the First Special Session where it belongs. So
- 10. with that explanation, I would ask for a favorable vote
- 11. on my motion.
- 12. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- Senator Hynes is recognized.
- 14. SENATOR HYNES:
- 15. Mr. President and members of the Senate. Senator
- 16. Glass is well intentioned, but in my judgment, the Journals
- 17. of the Senate do, in fact, accurately reflect what occurred
- 18. and I believe in the form that they are being presented, they
- 19. are accurate and should be adopted by and approved by this
- 20. Body and I therefore would resist and oppose Senator Glass'
- 21. motion.
- 22. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 23. Senator Glass.
- 24. SENATOR GLASS:
- 25. Thank you, Mr. President. By way of closing, I would
- 26. simply point out that the...the transcript of the proceedings
- 27. do indicate that Senator Donnewald, the Presiding Officer,
- 28. recognized that he had, in fact, adjourned the First Special
- 29. Session. He stated that it was adjourned and it should not
- 30. have been. So I think it's clear that there was an error
- 31. and there's certainly nothing wrong with that. We...we
- 32. do make errors in...in the proceedings. What...what I am
- 33. trying to do is set the record straight so that we cannot

- 1. and should not be confused in the future on...on this point.
- 2. And the point is simply that once a Session has been adjourned,
- 3. it simply can't be reopened. So again, with that closing, I
- 4. would urge a favorable vote on the motion.
- 5. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- Further discussion? All in favor say Aye. Opposed
- 7. Nay. The Nays have it, the motion is defeated. Further
- 8. business to come before the First Special Session? Resolutions.

- 11. (Secretary reads SR No. 7)
- 12. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 13. You heard the motion as read by the Secretary and
- 14. offered by Senator Rock. Is there discussion? All in favor
- 15. say Aye. Opposed Nay. The Ayes have it. The resolution
- 16. is adopted. Further resolutions?
- 17. SECRETARY:
- 18. Senate Joint Resolution No. 4.
- 19. (Secretary reads SJR No. 4)
- 20. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 21. Heard the motion that the First Special Session adjourn
- 22. sine die. Is there discussion? Senator Glass. We're adjourning
- 23. the First Special Session sine die by this motion ... resolution,
- 24. Joint Resolution. All in favor say Aye. Opposed Nay. The
- 25. Ayes have it. The First Special Session is adjourned sine die.
