6. Chicago Latvian Zion Lutheran Church, Mr. Willis Varsburg
7. and Tedis Vehrens. The Tedis Vehrens has been very
8. closely associated with Representative Pullen and they are
9. visiting here with us today, Governor, and I would ask
10. if you might be able to introduce them to the Senate ...
11. Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate.

14. my privilege to introduce Mr. Borvers to members of the
15. Senate and to the guests in the gallery. He is a young
16. Latvian refugee who is visiting this country and

19. Senators might find it interesting to speak with him
20. briefly during roll calls and he will be available to your
21. guests as well. Thank you, Senator Nimrod. Yes, Sir.
