1. Thank you, Mr. President. As an introduction to this
2. series of bills, let me merely advise the Senate. Senate
3. Bills 386, 388, 393, 395 and 1055 are bills that were heard
4. in the Senate Committee on Elementary and Secondary Education
5. on Tuesday and were unanimously voted out of that committee
6. with certain amendments. It was the agreement of the
7. Minority Spokesman in the committee, Senator Davidson and
8. myself, that we would add...put the...the committee amend-
9. ments on the bills today and allow the bills to remain...
10. allow the bills to remain on 2nd reading until at least
11. a week from next Wednesday, which I believe is May 10th,
12. in order for all members of the Senate as well as the public
13. to be able to obtain copies of the amendments and thoroughly
14. understand what these bills do. They're a special education
15. package to bring Illinois into conformity with Federal Law,
16. Public Law 94142 dealing with special education. On...with
17. that introduction, Mr. President, there were amendments
18. adopted last year to these bills...

19. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR ROCK)

20. Senator Davidson, for what purpose do you arise?

21. SENATOR DAVIDSON:

22. Just on an inquiry. Senator Berman, I don't know
23. whether it's technically, we need to ask for it first,
24. but in the committee there was a fiscal note asked in
25. relation to part of these bills and I don't know whether
26. that needs to be put on before we read it on 2nd reading
27. or not. I know there's a time when we ask for it.

5. I just want to echo what Senator Berman has said and
6. to the people on this side of the aisle as Minority Spokes-
7. man on the Education Committee, this is what we worked out,
8. worked on these amendments. We did tell all the witnesses,
9. public, that these amendments would be put on and so they
10. could be printed so they could see them and be held to the
11. date that he asked before we proceed with them.

20. Thank you, Mr. President. The reason I took Senate...the
21. reason that I took Senate Bill 389 out of the series of bills
22. that we had just completed is because I want it to be clear
23. that Senate Bill 389 does not fall into the same general
24. discription. Namely, the other bills that we've just completed
25. on 2nd reading and have remained on 2nd reading are bills that
26. respond to the mandates of Public Law 94142. If Illinois is
27. to conform to 94142 those bills are necessary. Senate Bill 389
28. is not of that nature. This is a permissive bill. This bill,
29. 389, is a bill that deals with the subject matter of providing
30. handicapped children educational services for the children who
31. are below the age of three, below the age of three. The
32. reason for this bill...the reason for this bill is that with the
33. passage of the Federal Law that mandates programs from three

1. through twenty-one. The programs that have existed in the
2. past for zero to three are not going to be funded by the
3. Federal program any longer. This bill, Senate Bill 389, is
4. a permissive bill that involves no State funding at all and
5. merely allows, within the total discretion of any local school
6. district, that school district to institute or maintain special
7. education programs for children zero to three years of age.
8. The...the committee amendment spells out that there is to
9. be no counting of any of these children for reimbursement
10. purposes or for AD, average daily attendance purposes, they
11. can only be funded out of the resources of the local school
12. district. With that explanation, Mr. President, I move the
13. adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 389.

15. Senator Berman has moved the adoption of Amendment No. 1

21. This bill can be advanced to 3rd reading if there's no...
22. no other objection.

24. All right. Senator Berman has indicated that the bill
25. will be advanced to 3rd reading and will be called back if
26. necessary. 3rd reading. On the Order of Senate Bills 2nd
27. reading, Senate Bill 1469.

29. Senate Bill 1469.

30. (Secretary reads title of bill)

31. 2nd reading of the bill. The Committee on Appropriations I
32. offers one amendment.

3. Thank you, Mr. President. The amendment simply puts

4. in the Department of Registration and Education as the

5. depository for the funds because the Illinois State Museum

6. is...is under that agency, therefore I would move for the

7. adoption of the amendment.

9. Senator Demuzio has moved the adoption of Amendment

10. No. 1 to Senate Bill 1469. All those in favor signify

11. by saying Aye. All those opposed. The Ayes have it,
