- 15. Depends on whose definition you use. I could
- 16. yield to Senator Lemke on that question, but

- 25. Just to note that last year they spent a little
- 26. under a hundred thousand dollars and they picked up
- 27. in matching funds eighty-five thousand...eighty
- 28. five thousand dollars, so what we're doing here is
- 29. to help to get more money for this program which is
- 30. furthered and being studied in the State of Illinois.
- 31. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)
- 32. Senator Regner.
- 33. SENATOR REGNER:

- 1. Yes, Mr. President, members of the Senate. I have
- 2. no argument at all with mandating the Art Council to
- 3. spend certain amounts of money on ethnic art. However,
- 4. there's more than ample monies of wasted spending
- 5. in this budget that this could be taken or transferred
- 6. from and we certainly don't have to appropriate
- 7. another seventy-five thousand dollars over and above
- 8. the budget of General Revenue monies when the treasury
- 9. is strapped as it is and I would urge the defeat
- 10. of this amendment and if somebody believes that we should
