3. hour of 4:30. I would move to suspend the rules and ask
4. for the immediate consideration and adoption of this

9. the resolution. All those in favor signify by saying
10. Aye. Opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended.

5. For what purpose does Senator Rock arise?

6. SENATOR ROCK:

7. Thank you, Mr. President, parliamentary inquiry.

8. At...at what point in the proceeding during the course
9. of a Special Session are we authorized or otherwise
10. empowered to question whether or not a proposal or
11. a bill introduced is...is, in fact, within the purview
12. of the call?

13. PRESIDENT:

14. At any time after the bill has been introduced and
15. read by the Secretary so that it is before the Body.

16. SENATOR ROCK:

17. Well then...then I suggest to the Chair and would
18. request a ruling that Senate Bills 9...(Machine cutoff)
19. ...thank you, that million dollar system is still
20. operative...that Senate Bills 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15
21. and 16, I would question. And submit to the Chair that
22. they are not, in fact, within the purview of the call
23. of the Governor for the Second Special Session. I would
24. ask the Secretary to...if the membership so desires, to
25. again read those bills by title and indicate the substance
26. and then I would question their...whether or not they
27. are, in fact, within the purview of the call.

28. PRESIDENT:

29. For what purpose does Senator Weaver arise?

30. SENATOR WEAVER:

31. Well, Mr. President, yesterday we adopted an amendment to the
32. temporary rules. Shouldn't they...first be considered
33. by the Rules Committee before we question the validity?

1. Senate Bill No. 12 introduced by the same sponsors.

2. (Secretary reads title of Senate Bill)

3. It increases the disqualification of claimants who are
4. discharged for cause.

5. Senate Bill No. 13 introduced by the same sponsors.

6. (Secretary reads title of Senate Bill)

7. It requires the consideration of all timely employer
8. objections to eligibility.

9. PRESIDENT:

10. For what purpose does Senator Glass arise?

11. SENATOR GLASS:

12. For a point of order, Mr. President. Is this not
13. a Perfunctory Session?

14. PRESIDENT:

15. There is in our rules no provision for a Perfunctory
16. Session. I presently am discussing the problem that you
17. are about to get to with Senator Weaver and I think we
18. ought to, as soon as the Secretary has finished reading
19. the captions of these bills, stand at ease for just a
20. moment and have a brief conference. For what purpose
21. does Senator Rock arise?

22. SENATOR ROCK:

23. I think, frankly, Senator Glass' point is well
24. taken. And I did not mean to bring up a matter of this
25. kind of substance in what was, at least generally under-
26. stood, to be a Session without this kind of substance.
27. I would propose, therefore, if the Chair and the members
28. of the other side agree, that I will submit this in
29. writing and ask that it be deferred or delayed until
30. next week. Now, that will, I...I think, not allow these
31. bills, at least, to go to committee. You know...I...I
32. just don't know how else to do it.

33. PRESIDENT:

34. Rather than...the Senate will stand at ease for a

1. moment. Senator Shapiro...Senator Shapiro, could...would
2. you come up for a moment. The Senate will stand at ease
3. for just a moment. The Senate will please come to order.
4. There is an understanding that Senator Rock will file his
5. motion requesting a ruling of the Chair and...challenging
6. the germaneness of these bills, questioning whether they
7. come within the purview of the call. That motion will
8. be heard and the Chair will rule on Wednesday when we
9. return to Session and that the bills will remain on
10. the Secretary's Desk until that time. With leave of
11. the membership, we will follow that procedure. Leave
12. is granted. So ordered. The bills will remain on the
13. Secretary's Desk. Senator Rock's Motion in Writing
14. will be taken up on...on Wednesday. Is there any further
15. business to come before the Second Special Session?
16. If not, the Second Special Session will...will stand
17. in recess subject...subject to call, the call of the
18. Chair, as with the First Special Session.

7. Session stands adjourned.

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
