2. several of us think that it ought to be recommitted. It's a
3. bill that I'm violently opposed to, but everyone ought to
4. have their day in court. It's to elect the...to not elect
5. the Board of Trustees, University of Illinois. Talked to
6. Senator Weaver, he understands that we are going to recommit
7. this bill, it will not be called in this Session. And so
8. my motion is to take from the Table and to recommit Senate
9. Bill 196 to the Senate Committee on Higher Education.
