21. wishes to recall for purposes of amendment, we could probably get
22. that done, and then we will...adjourn and I'm going to suggest that
23. we adjourn until 11 o'clock tomorrow morning. It is Friday tomorrow
24. and one of the last few weekends we will be able to spend at home for
25. the next couple of weeks. So I'm going to suggest that we try to
26. begin promptly at 11 o'clock with the hope that we can all leave here
27. by...as early as 2 o'clock.

31. I want to make a motion to Table House Bill 1568 which resides
32. in the Pension Laws Committee. 1568.

1. Motion is to discharge Senate Bill...House Bill 1568 from
2. the Committee on Pensions. All in favor say Aye. All opposed Nay.
3. The Ayes have it. The bill is discharged. Now Senator D'Arco moves
4. to Table Senate...House Bill 1568. On the motion, those in favor
5. say Aye. Those opposed Nay. The Ayes have it. House Bill 1568
6. is Tabled. Is there leave to go to the House...Order of House
7. Bills 2nd reading? Leave is granted. House Bills 2nd reading.
8. House Bill 35, Senator Netsch. Is Senator Netsch on the Floor?
9. For what purpose does Senator Graham arise?

10. SENATOR GRAHAM:

11. I...I'm sure no one going to hear but I'll try. Senator Rock.

12. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)

13. Could we have some order please.

14. SENATOR GRAHAM:

15. Senator Rock, before Bob Hedges from Corrections has a
16. hemorrhage over this 945 bill which a message is back on, not shown
17. on the Calendar, they see some great importance on having that
18. concurred in today. Could we suspend the rules for the Order of
19. Business and concur in the House amendment to the Senate Bill 945?
20. That's a Corrections bill.

21. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)

22. Senator Rock.

23. SENATOR ROCK:

24. Yes, I'm aware there were four Messages from the House dealing
25. with FY 79 appropriations bill. They have just been read in and
26. ordered to the Secretary's Desk on the Order of Concurrence. If it's
27. your desire to move to that order, I'm sure we can accommodate
28. that.

29. SENATOR GRAHAM:

30. I would appreciate it.

32. All right. Senator Bruce, do you want to do that right now?

14. the House Amendment to Senate Bill 945.

21. would take our conferences off the Floor. Senator Buzbee on a motion
22. to concur House Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 945. Senator

25. I don't know what the amendment does, Mr. President, that's...
26. I couldn't hear...

28. It certainly wasn't your fault...

30. ...85 people were talking to him...

31. PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR BRUCE)

32. It certainly wasn't Senator Buzbee's fault that he couldn't
33. hear. Senator Graham, would you please explain House Amendment No.
1, again?

1. SENATOR GRAHAM:

2. Senator Buzbee, the House took out of the funds that was in
3. the Senate Bill for boarding the gang leaders at the Federal
4. Penitentiaries. They took out a hundred and twenty thousand dollars.

8. I have asked for concurrence.

10. Okay, Senator, what...what are we going to do with those folks

5. from Nash to McMillan-Nash and that the bill be reassigned from
6. Judiciary to Agriculture.
