13. Thank you, Father. Reading of the Journal. Senator

15. SENATOR HALL:

16. Mr. President, I move that reading and approval of the

21. You've heard the motion. All in favor signify by saying

25. Senator Gene Johns, Chairman of the Committee on Committees
26. makes the following temporary committee assignments. To be
27. Chairman of Revenue Committee, to replace Senator Robert J.
28. Egan, Senator Philip J. Rock. Vice-chairman of Revenue Committee
29. to replace Senator Sam C. Maragos, Senator Frank D. Savickas.
30. These temporary assignments will terminate on November the
