PRESIDENT:

Message from the Secretary of State, Mr. Secretary.

SECRETARY:

To the Honorable members of the Senate of the 84th General Assembly.

Enclosed is a copy of a Proclamation issued by Governor James R. Thompson calling a Third Special Session of the 84th General Assembly. Signed, James Edgar, Secretary of State.

State of Illinois, Executive Department, Proclamation.

(Secretary reads Proclamation)

PRESIDENT:

All right. Pursuant to the Governor's Proclamation, the Third Special Session will please come to order. Resolutions, Mr. Secretary.

SECRETARY:

Senate Resolution No. 1 offered by Senator Demuzio.

(Secretary reads SR No. 1)

PRESIDENT:

Senator Demuzio.

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Thank you, Mr. President. Senate Resolution No. 1, in fact, does as...Secretary indicates...adopts the temporary rules of the Senate of the Third Special Session of the 84th General Assembly. I would move adoption of Senate Resolution No. 1.

PRESIDENT:

All right. Senator Demuzio has moved the adoption of Senate Resolution No. 1. Any discussion? If not, all in favor indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted. Further resolutions, Mr. Secretary?

SECRETARY:

Senate Resolution No. 2 offered by Senator Demuzio.

(Secretary reads SR No. 2)

PRESIDENT:

Senator Demuzio.

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Yes, Senate Resolution No. 2 indicates that we would adopt the standing committees and the same membership and the same officers that has...been read by the Secretary. I move adoption of Senate...Resolution No. 2.

PRESIDENT:

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Senate Resolution No. 3, Mr. President, ladies and gentlemen, indicates that the Senate is now...constructed in terms of a majority being present and informs the House that we are ready for the transaction of business. I move adoption of Senate Resolution No. 3.

Senate Resolution No. 4 offered by Senator Demuzio.

(Secretary reads SR No. 4)

PRESIDENT:

Senator Demuzio.

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Senate Resolution No. 4 indicates that we notify the Governor that we are ready to do business. I would move adoption of Senate Resolution No. 4.

PRESIDENT:
