All right, Senator Berman has moved to discharge the Committee on Assignment of Bills from further consideration of Senate Bill 651 and 652 and asked that the bills be read a second time and placed on the calendar on the Order of 3rd Reading. Senator Kustra.

SENATOR KUSTRA:

Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Senate. Mr. President we on now?

PRESIDENT:

We are. Yeah, there you go.

SENATOR KUSTRA:

Mr. President and members of the Senate, just to elaborate the need to bypass committee and move these bills forward as fast as possible. Couple of weeks ago Senator Berman chaired a meeting in Chicago which was designed to take a look at how Chicago school reform is coming along. One of the groups we heard from were the Chicago school parents who reported to us that the job of getting parents to serve on school councils has been made more difficult by some opponents to Chicago school reform who are running around telling these parents that if they serve on a local school council they are going to lose their homes and their property because they will be sued for what actions they might take. Of course, that's nonsense, but to make sure that these people are safe in their new positions as school council members we need that indemnification provision which one of these bills provides. I also think makes good sense to move up the date of the bill. Members on this side of the aisle fought from the very beginning for the earliest

possible adoption of this legislation, and this gives the new mayor of Chicago the earliest opportunity to put new school board members on there. So, I am all in favor of this proposal. I hope that we can move it with expedition through the General Assembly. PRESIDENT:

All right, the motion is to discharge the Committee on Assignment from further consideration of Senate Bills 651 and 652. The sponsor has asked that the bills be read a second time and placed on the Order of 3rd Reading. Further discussion? Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES:

Yeah, thank you, Mr. President. Senator Berman. I...I spoke with you on this issue yesterday as it relate to the school councils, and I concur with Senator Kustra in his remarks as it relate to the...the indemnification of these local school councils. However, we recognize that there are persons who are in strong opposition to the legislation running around here...around the community confusing people. And that portion as it relates to the election of the school councils, are we moving that date up equally as well?

The election of the councils will not be advanced merely by the advancing of the effective date.
