PRESIDENT ROCK:

Thank you, Mr. President. I move that reading and approval of the Journals of Wednesday, April 10th, and Thursday, April the 11th, in the year 1991, be postponed, pending arrival of the printed Journals.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. You've heard the motion as placed by Senator Hall. Any discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The motion carries, and it is so ordered. It appears there is no further business to come before the First Special Session, except for the adjournment message from the House. Madam Secretary.

A Message from the House by Mr. O'Brien, Clerk.

Mr. President - I am directed to inform the Senate that the House of Representatives has adopted the following joint resolution, in the adoption of which I am instructed to ask the concurrence of the Senate, to wit:
