PRESIDENT ROCK:

You've heard the motion as placed by Senator Hall. Is there any discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The motion carries. It's so ordered. Further business or announcements to come before the Senate in the First Special Session? Senator Friedland.

SENATOR FRIEDLAND:

Thank -- thank you, Mr. President. I'd like to introduce, from the Gallery behind the Republican side, the fifth grade class from Willard School in South Elgin. Would you please make them welcome to Springfield.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Will our guests please rise and be recognized. Welcome to Springfield. ...(machine cutoff)...right. If there's no further business to come before the Senate, Senator Hall moves the Senate, in the First Special Session, stand adjourned until the hour of eleven-thirty. Eleven-thirty tomorrow morning, Ladies and Gentlemen. Regular Session will convene at eleven. Please be ready to get on the Calendar. Senate stands adjourned until tomorrow.
