I would move to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of Senate Joint Resolution 6.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Senator Demuzio has moved to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of Senate Joint Resolution 6. All in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution -- the rules are suspended. Senator Demuzio now moves the adoption of Senate Joint Resolution No. 6 - the adjournment resolution - calling for us to return next Tuesday. All in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted. Further business to come before the First Special Session? Announcements? If not, Senator Demuzio moves that the Senate, in the First Special Session of the Eighty-seventh General Assembly, stand adjourned until Tuesday, April 30, at twelve-thirty o'clock p.m. Senate stands adjourned.
